Burnable Garbage

Mon/Thur: Amagi, Hinashiro, Minagi-no-mori, Takagi, and Mada (except Sozu)
Tues/Fri: Akizuki, Yasukawa, Tateishi, Minagi, Kanakawa, Kamiakizuki, Fukuda, and Mada (Sozu only)

Place designated garbage bags out by **8:30 AM** on collection days.
Even if the collection day falls on a **national holiday**, collection will be **conducted as usual**.
However, collection will not be conducted during the year-end and New Year holidays (December 31-January 3).

For household burnable garbage: 45L (L) : 1,000 yen (20 bags)
27L (S) : 600 yen (20 bags)
18L (Mini) : 400 yen (20 bags)

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Kitchen Waste
 ■ Plastic
 ■ Wooden scraps
 ■ Non-recyclable paper

Items that cannot be collected:
 ■ Non-recyclable cloth
 ■ Leather
 ■ Others

Please do not put glass, bottles, or other non-burnable items in garbage bags, as they are dangerous!
Please drain water well before disposing kitchen waste.
In the event that collection is unavoidably cancelled due to bad weather conditions such as typhoons or snow, please dispose of the garbage on the next collection day.

Bulky Garbage

Combustible/non-combustible bulky garbage

Examples Tables, chairs, desks, wardrobes, bicycles, stoves, futons, tin cans, etc.

Collection requirements
 Size limit: 2m x 1.2m long and under 50cm tall (However, construction debris, wood such as branches and logs must be less than 1m long x 20cm thick)
 Carpets and other items that can be rolled up should not exceed 2m long and 30cm thick.
 Weight: Within 50 kg, which can be carried by two people.
Items exceeding size or weight limits will not be collected.

Please dispose of the items without obstructing traffic.

How to take out
 ① Call to make an appointment for collection at least 5 days in advance.
 ② Purchase a sticker (310 yen/sheet) and affix it to your bulky garbage. They are sold at the same place as designated garbage bags.
 ③ Take them out in front of your house on the day of collection.
If it is not taken out, it cannot be collected.
 You can also bring in bulky waste directly.

Waste Paper and Used Cloths

Please take the garbage for group collection by each school PTA, etc.

For waste paper and cardboard, the Environment Division also collects them.

Paper cartons, white trays, PET bottles

These are also collected at supermarkets and other stores that cooperate with in-store collection.

TVs, Washing Machines, Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, etc.

Ask the store where you purchased the product or where you are replacing it to pick them up for a fee.

Or pay a fee to the city's partner company (Renet Japan Recycle) and have them pick up the items from your home.

Recycle Workshop will come to your home to pick up items that are no longer needed at home and that are deemed reusable with only minor repairs. There is no charge for pickup. However, if the staff determines that there is no one to take over the items after repairing them, they will be disposed of as bulky garbage.

Items that can be collected
 Furniture (cupboards, wardrobes, desks, beds, tables, etc.), bicycles, clothing (generally, only unused items are accepted, but old kimonos, obis, and denim are also acceptable), books (excluding dictionaries, encyclopedias, and magazines)

Items that cannot be collected
 Televisions, washing machines, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, clothes dryers, and PCs cannot be collected.

Pick-up times
 Every Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (except national holidays)

Recyclable/non-burnable garbage

Take to local collection points for sorting.

There is no need to forcibly remove labels from cans and bottles.

Paper Containers & Packaging

Items with paper containers and packaging symbol (紙) on it.
Tie crosswise and take it out.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Snack boxes
 ■ Paper containers for ice cream
 ■ Paper containers for detergent
 ■ Paper bags, wrapping paper
 ■ Paper boxes for food, etc.

Please clean the inside of the container and fold it up. Wet or soiled items will not be accepted. (Dispose of as burnable garbage)

PET bottles

Items with PET bottles symbol (PET) on it.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Beverages: Carbonated drinks, fruit juices, mineral water, coffee, tea, etc.
 ■ Alcoholic beverages: Sake, shochu, mirin, etc.
 ■ Soy sauce

Remove caps and labels, rinse, and dry before disposal without crushing.
Items containing cooking oil, vinegar, or kitchen detergent should be placed in plastic containers.

Plastic Containers & Packaging

Items with plastic containers and packaging symbol (プラ) on it.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Shampoo containers
 ■ Kitchen detergent containers
 ■ Cooking oil containers
 ■ Seasoning containers
 ■ Cup noodle containers
 ■ Plastic bags, etc.

Clean and dry containers before disposal. Soiled items will not be accepted. (Dispose of as burnable garbage)

Aluminum & Steel cans

Cans and lids that contained food or drink.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Beverages cans
 ■ Snack cans
 ■ Seaweed cans, etc.

Only cans that contained food or drink.
 Do not crush, rinse inside, clean and take out. Cooking oil cans should be sorted as miscellaneous.

Paper cartons

Items with paper cartons symbol (紙パック) on it. Those without aluminum on the inside.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Milk cartons
 ■ Fruit juice cartons, etc.

Rinse the inside, cut it open, dry it, and tie it crosswise with string before disposal.
Items with aluminum on the inside should be sorted as paper containers.

Caution
 Bottles are only those contained food or drink. Makeup bottles, baby bottles, heat-resistant glass, etc., should be sorted as miscellaneous. Spray cans should be removed after making a hole in them.

Bottles (Clear and Colorless)

Bottles that contain food or drink and are clear and colorless.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Liquor bottles, one-cup bottles
 ■ Seasoning bottles ■ Medicine bottles, etc.

Remove lids (caps) and labels, rinse the inside, and dry before disposal.

Bottles (Brown)

Bottles that used to contain food or drink and are brown in color.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Liquor bottles ■ Seasoning bottles
 ■ Nutritional drink bottles ■ Medicine bottles, etc.

Remove lids (caps) and labels, rinse the inside, and dry before disposal.

Bottles (Other colors)

Bottles that contain food or drink and are not colorless, transparent, or brown in color.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Liquor bottles ■ Seasoning bottles
 ■ Medicine bottles, etc.

Remove lids (caps) and labels, rinse the inside, and dry before disposal.

Miscellaneous

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Mixtures of metals and other materials: Crowns, caps, metal toys, etc.
 ■ Metals other than food and beverage container cans: Spray cans, paint cans, etc.
 ■ Small household appliances
 ■ Pottery and glass: Glass panels, vases, glass cups, tea cups, teapot, baby bottles, etc.
 ■ Bottles other than food and beverage containers: Mirrors, makeup bottles, etc.

For items that have been used as containers, please use up the contents and clean them before disposing. Items that can fit into containers are accepted. Spray cans should be used up, holes should be made, and lids should be removed. Knives, etc. should be wrapped in paper before disposing.

Hazardous Waste

Remove fluorescent tube cases and dispose of tubes intact.

Items that can be collected:
 ■ Dry cell batteries
 ■ Rectangular and cylindrical batteries
 ■ Button Cell Batteries
 ■ Batteries for video cameras, etc.
 ■ Thermometers

Only mercury thermometers are accepted. Broken ones should be wrapped in paper and take out.

Hard Metals

Items that are hard, difficult to crush, or can entangle in machinery.

Items that are difficult to shred: Hammer, pliers, screwdriver, shovel, etc.
Entangled objects: Wire cables, cleaning hangers, etc.
 Please remove non-metallic attachments as much as possible.

Personal Computers

Disposal of home PCs (the following two methods are available)
 ① Free collection by courier service
 A city-affiliated business will arrange for free collection by delivery service. For application and details, please refer to the website of the government-approved business, Renet Japan Recycle Co. Inquiries 0570-085-800 10:00 - 17:00 (except year-end and New Year holidays)
 ② Request the PC manufacturer to dispose of your PC
 Manufacturers and retailers may offer collection services. (Some are paid services) Please contact the manufacturer for inquiries. For self-assembled PCs, please contact the PC3R Promotion Association. TEL 03-5282-7685

Items that cannot be collected

Items that are difficult to dispose of as industrial waste:
 Please ask the shop or specialist to dispose of these items.
In principle, business establishments must dispose of their own waste.

Carry in

Garbage from homes and businesses can be carried to the disposal facility (Sun Port) by individuals.

Items that can be carried in
 Burnable garbage, bulky garbage (combustible and non-combustible), and recyclable garbage

Designated bag is not needed for disposal.
Sticker on the garbage is not needed for disposal.

Year-end and New Year's vacations: Notified in the newsletter "Asakura".
 Other vacations: Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays except the third Sunday of the month
