



Burnable Garbage 2 times/week: Local station



Paper waste, wood waste, plastic products, food scraps, and other items made of combustible materials.
Please use special bags designated by the city.
Please cooperate in home processing of food waste.

- **Paper**
Non-recyclable items
- **Bedding**
Cushions, blankets, curtains, etc.
- **Plastics**
Video tapes, CDs, rain coats, etc.
- **Rubber and leather**
Bags, shoes, etc.

Collection Day

Asakura and Miyano areas: Monday and Thursday
Daifuku area: Tuesday and Friday
Even if the collection day falls on a national holiday, collection will be conducted as usual. However collection will not be conducted during the year-end and New Year holidays (December 31-January 3).

Dedicated Bags

For household burnable garbage:
45L (L) : 1,000 yen (20 bags)
27L (S) : 600 yen (20 bags)
18L (Mini) : 400 yen (20 bags)

Waste Paper & Used Cloths Several times/year



Used Cloths
Clothes, underwear, towels, and other fabrics. Please wash, tie and take out. Underwear and soiled items will not be accepted.

Newspapers
Please tie crosswise with string before disposal.
■ Newspapers
■ Flyers
■ Advertisements

Magazines
Please tie crosswise with string before disposal.
■ Books (books, dictionaries, etc.)
■ Magazines (weekly, monthly, etc.)
■ Others (letter paper, etc.)

Cardboard
Please tie crosswise with string before disposal.
■ Cardboard

For the disposal of used paper and cloth, please use the group collection service provided by the group collection organization.
Please inquire with the collection organization regarding collection dates and details.
Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard boxes are also collected by the Environment Division.

Bulky Garbage Reservations accepted Mon-Fri (except holidays)



Combustible Bulky Garbage
Items made of wood, plastic, or other combustible materials that do not fit into the dedicated bags for burnable garbage.

- **Futon blankets**
- **Carpets**
Tie with string
- **Furniture**
Drawers, desks, chairs, etc.
- **Carpets, rugs, etc.**
- **Sofas, mattresses**



Non-combustible bulky Garbage
Items made of metal, a mixture of metal and other materials, or non-burnable materials that do not fit in containers.

- **Furniture**
- **Unicycles, bicycles**
- **Sashes, stepladders**
- **Appliances, etc.** (Except air conditioners, televisions, washing machines, refrigerators, etc.)

Collection requirements

Size limit: Carpets and similar items that can be rolled up must not exceed 2m x 1.2m x 30cm long.
*Waste wood and branches must not exceed 1m long x 20cm thick.
Weight: Which can be carried by two people.
Items exceeding size or weight limits will not be collected.

How to take out

Call to make an appointment for collection at least 5 days in advance.

Purchase stickers (310 yen/sheet). They are sold at the same place as designated garbage bags. Take them out in front of your house on the day of collection.

If it is not taken out, it cannot be collected. You can also bring in bulky waste directly.



Please dispose of the items without obstructing traffic.

Recycle Workshop will come to your home to pick up items that are no longer needed at home and that are deemed reusable with only minor repairs. There is no charge for pickup. However, if the staff determines that there is no one to take over the items after repairing them, they will be disposed of as bulky garbage.

■ **Items that can be collected** Furniture (cupboards, wardrobes, desks, beds, tables, etc.), bicycles, clothing (generally, only unused items are accepted, but old kimonos, obis, and denim are also acceptable), books (excluding dictionaries, encyclopedias, and magazines)

■ **Items that cannot be collected** Televisions, washing machines, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, clothes dryers, and PCs cannot be collected.

■ **Pick-up times** Every Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (except national holidays)

Recyclable/non-burnable garbage Once per month: Local station

Items to be collected monthly

PET Bottles



Remove caps and labels, rinse, and dry before disposal.
Items containing cooking oil, vinegar, or kitchen detergent should be placed in plastic containers.

Basket

Items with PET bottles symbol (♻️) on it.
■ **Beverages**
Carbonated drinks, fruit juices, mineral water, coffee, tea, etc.
■ **Alcoholic beverages**
Sake, shochu, mirin, etc.
■ **Soy sauce**

Paper Cartons



Rinse the inside, cut it open, dry it, and tie it crosswise with string before disposal.
Items with aluminum on the inside should be sorted as paper containers.

Blue container

Items with paper cartons symbol (♻️) on it. Those without aluminum on the inside.
■ **Milk cartons**
■ **Fruit juice cartons, etc.**

Paper Containers and Packaging



Please clean the inside of the container and fold it up.
Wet or soiled items will not be accepted. (Dispose of as burnable garbage)

Basket

Items with paper containers and packaging symbol (♻️) on it.
■ **Snack boxes**
■ **Paper containers for ice cream**
■ **Paper containers for detergent**
■ **Paper bags, wrapping paper**
■ **Paper boxes for food, etc.**

Plastic Containers and Packaging



Clean and dry containers before disposal.
Soiled items will not be accepted. (Dispose as burnable garbage)

Basket

Items with plastic containers and packaging symbol (♻️) on it.
■ **Shampoo containers**
■ **Kitchen detergent containers**
■ **Cooking oil containers**
■ **Seasoning Containers**
■ **Cup noodle containers**
■ **Trays**
■ **Plastic bags, etc.**

Items to be collected in even-numbered months

Aluminum Cans and Other Cans



Only cans that contained food or drink.
Do not crush, rinse inside, clean and take out.
Cooking oil cans should be sorted as miscellaneous (metal and appliances).

Basket

Cans and lids that contained food or drink.
■ **Beverages cans**
■ **Snack cans**
■ **Seaweed cans, etc.**

Hard Metals




Please remove non-metallic attachments as much as possible.
Place them in this container.

Yellow Container

Items that are hard, difficult to crush, or can entangle in machinery.
■ **Items that are difficult to shred**
Hammer, pliers, screwdriver, shovel, etc.
■ **Entangled objects**
Wire cables, cleaning hangers, etc.

Miscellaneous (metal and appliances)



For items that have been used as containers, please use up the contents and clean them before disposing. Items that can fit into containers are accepted. Spray cans should be used up, holes should be made, and lids should be removed. Knives, etc. should be wrapped in paper before disposing.

Blue container

Items made of metallic materials that cannot be separated into other categories.
Up to the size of the container (60cm x 40cm x 30cm)
■ **Mixtures of metals and other materials**
Crowns, caps, metal toys, etc.
■ **Metals other than food and beverage container cans**
Spray cans, paint cans, etc.
■ **Small household appliances**

Items to be collected in odd-numbered months

Clear Colorless Bottles



Only bottles that contained food and beverages.

Blue Container

Bottles that contain food or drink and are clear and colorless.
■ **Liquor bottles, one-cup bottles**
■ **Seasoning bottles**
■ **Medicine bottles, etc.**

Brown Bottles



Please remove lids (caps) and inner lids, rinse the inside, and sort by color when disposing.
Broken bottles should be sorted by color and disposed of accordingly.

Blue Container

Bottles that used to contain food or drink and are brown in color.
■ **Liquor bottles**
■ **Nutritional drink bottles**
■ **Seasoning bottles**
■ **Medicine bottles, etc.**

Other Colored Bottles



Oil bottles should be disposed of as miscellaneous (ceramic/glass).
Please dispose of one-sho bottles and beer bottles at a liquor store or group collection.

Blue Container

Bottles that contain food or drink and are not colorless, transparent, or brown in color.
■ **Liquor bottles**
■ **Seasoning bottles**
■ **Medicine bottles, etc.**

Miscellaneous (ceramic and glass)



For items that have been used as containers, please use up the contents and clean them before disposing. Items that can fit into containers are accepted.

Blue container

Items made of ceramic or glass-type materials that cannot be separated into other categories.
Up to the size of the container (60cm x 40cm x 30cm)
■ **Pottery and glass**
Glass panels, vases, glass cups, tea cups, teapot, baby bottles, etc.
■ **Bottles other than food and beverage containers**
Mirrors, makeup bottles, etc.

Hazardous Waste



Rod fluorescent tubes
Please remove the case and dispose of them without breaking them.
Dedicated Container



Round fluorescent tubes
Please remove the case and dispose of them without breaking them.
Blue Container



Light bulbs and broken fluorescent tubes
Broken fluorescent tubes and light bulbs
■ **Broken fluorescent tubes**
■ **Light bulbs, glow lamps, etc.**
Blue Container



Dry cell batteries
■ **Rectangular and cylindrical batteries**
■ **Button Cell Batteries**
■ **Batteries for video cameras, etc.**
*Except batteries for cars
Blue Container



Thermometers
Only mercury thermometers are accepted.
Broken ones should be wrapped in paper and take out.
Blue Container

Carry In

Garbage from homes and businesses can be carried to the disposal facility (Sun Port) by individuals.

Items that can be carried in...Burnable garbage, bulky garbage (combustible and non-combustible), and recyclable garbage

Designated bag is not needed for disposal.
Sticker on the garbage is not needed for disposal.

Year-end and New Year's vacations: Notified in the newsletter "Asakura".
Other vacations: Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays except the third Sunday of the month

Items That Cannot Be Collected

Please ask the shop or specialized company to dispose of following items.

- **Industrial waste:** Garbage generated from business activities (except general waste)
Medical waste, industrial equipment, sludge, waste oil, construction waste, agricultural equipment, pesticide bottles and cans, etc.
- **Hazardous materials**
Agricultural chemicals, deleterious chemicals, paints, etc.
- **Items that are difficult to process**
Cars, motorcycles (over 50cc), tires, gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, fireproof safes, boilers, batteries, blocks, etc.
